Our Hill & Valley wines showcase the great diversity of the regions surrounding the winery. From the cooler Adelaide Hills to the elevated Eden Valley vineyards to those situated on the Barossa Valley floor, these ancient soils provide the base for great wines that speak of their origins.

The Barossa is acknowledged as the home of the world's great Shiraz – its unmatched style and character define a place, a wine region. No wonder Peter Lehmann's first released wine was a Barossa Shiraz, with the traditional style still upheld for over 3 decades.

Winemaker's note	The monumental 2013 vintage in the Barossa has produced a deeply coloured, brooding shiraz showing chocolate and dark plum notes. The palate shows great richness and finishes with firm tannins- a wine that can be aged with confidence for many years.
Vintage	The 2013 vintage was our earliest and one of the driest and quickest for many years. The weather remained warm to hot throughout but without any extended heat waves and the unusually small crop has produced highly coloured, richly structured red wines destined for many years in the cellar- an outstanding red wine vintage.
Vineyards	Low yielding, high quality vineyards mainly in the northern Barossa.
Winemaking	The wine was fermented on skins for up to two weeks to maximise colour and flavour and then aged for 12 months in French oak hogsheads.
Enjoy	A perfect accompaniment to a spicy beef stir-fry, barbecued chorizo sausage or a great parmesan.
Analysis	Alc/vol 14% T.A 6.4g/L p/H 3.55 RS 2.9g/L
