## ETNA ROSATO DOC FEUDO PIGNATONE SCIAURO 2021



Etna Rosè Feudo Pignatone Sciauro comes from a selection of Nerello Mascalese grapes of Contrada Feudo Pignatone on the northern side of the highest active Volcano in Europe at about 700 meters above sea level, the grapes, organically grown, come from vineyards of 30-100 years old.

The selection of grapes destined to Feudo Pignatone Rosato Sciauro takes place meticulously in the vineyard so to produce a fresh, mineral and savory rosè, an unmistakable ambassador of the vine and the terroir of origin

Vintage 2021 climate trend: the 2021 vintage began with a mild winter that favored early vegetative recovery, followed in mid-April by sudden drops in temperature which slowed down the development and the vegetative cycle. The Summer is characterized by a period of high temperatures in the month of July and then normalized in August, continuing then in the sign of good weather. In September, some rains rebalanced the ripeness and vegetative cycle allowing the harvest of perfectly health and in balance grapes.

Fermentation: spontaneous, carried out by yeasts naturally present on the grapes in oak casks

Vinificazione: the grapes are manually harvested and pressed immediately, followed by the static clarification of the must and the following alcoholic fermentation in small oak casks

Ageing: in oak casks for three months and then in stainless steel

Bottiling: 10th March 2022

Number of bottles: 1.490 bottles of 750 ml
