FRUIT SOURCE Fruit for the blend was taken from 3 single vineyard sites across the Barossa region. The Grenache was sourced from Dan Falkenberg's family vineyard (2018 Barossa Viticulturist of the Year) in the Barossa Valley, the Shiraz from the Avon Brae vineyard in the Eden Valley, and the Mataro from a vineyard near Moculta in the Barossa Valley..

2018 VINTAGE NOTES The 2018 growing season started off well following above average winter rainfall, but it was dry and warm after that. Owing to later veraison in the Eden Valley as opposed to the Barossa floor, the hot spell in January and February did not cause any concern to the Avon Brae vineyard and the vines took it all comfortably in their stride.

Thankfully, Mother Nature did not dish out any adverse events this year and harvest started in March with the whites, and finished on 19 April with the last of the Cabernet blocks. Yields were above average across the board, but quality was good, with Riesling a standout as usual.

For the first foray with this Rhone style blend we chose the brilliant 2018 vintage and are very pleased with the outcome! The wine is garnet red in colour with spice and raspberries on the nose that follow through on the palate. A playful wine that is
